The monthly meeting of the Lanesville Community School Board of Trustees was held June 16, 2026 at the high school cafeteria, 2725 Crestview Avenue, NE, Lanesville Indiana. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by board President, Ryan Lind. The following members were present:

Dr. Ryan Apple, Superintendent

Sharon Rothrock made the motion to approve the minutes from the May 19, 2026 board meeting. Tim Bridges seconded the motion. Motion passed 4-0.

Donnie Hussung made the motion to approve the claims and payroll for the month of June. Tim Bridges seconded the motion. Motion passed 4-0.

Aric Miller, High School principal was not present at this meeting. Dr. Ryan Apple proceeded with Mr. Miller's report.

Mr. Miller said he was sorry he was not able to attend the meeting. He added that he hoped everyone was having a great summer break. He said we have our 7th grade/ new student orientation scheduled for July 27th starting at 5:00pm. He said this is a good time to get information about classes and get to walk your schedule.

Mr. Miller said he also wanted to take a moment to say thanks to those who have been helping at the school over the recent flood. He said he knew there were many but wanted to take an extra moment to thank Paul Hancock and Matthew Crawford for their work making sure that things ran smoothly. He said there has been a lot of loss in the Lanesville community and it is always great to see so many in the community come together to help.

Dr. Apple said his heart goes out to everyone in the Lanesville and Corydon communities who lost so much during the flooding last week. He said that LCSC has some athletic

facilities that need to be repaired, but for others in Harrison County, their lives will forever be altered. He added that LCSC will do all it can to assist those who lost their homes and their livelihoods due to flooding in our area.

Dr. Apple said LCSC is currently seeking quotes for the damage done to the baseball field and the soccer/track complex. He said he would like to personally thank all of those that assisted in the cleanup efforts to get this community and LCSC back on its feet.

He said LCSC is looking to secure a \$25,000 grant from the Harrison County Community Foundation to help start repairs to the baseball and soccer/track complex.

Dr. Apple discussed/presented the results from the parent and student survey that was given at the end of the year.

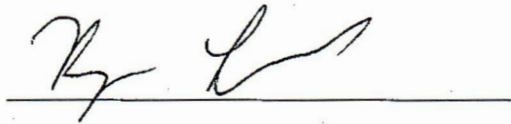

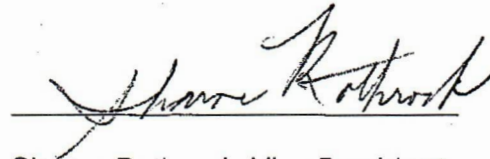
Sharon Rothrock made the motion to accept and Tim Bridges seconded the motion. Motion passed 4-0.
